



## Lawrence Vik

December 2, 1918 - December 21, 2006

Lawrence Vik, 88, died December 21, 2006 at Medcenter One, Bismarck. Services will be held at 1:00 pm Friday at the Medcenter One Golden Manor Chapel in Steele with Rev. Bob Schoepp officiating. There will be no visitation as cremation has taken place. Burial will be held at Tuttle Cemetery, Tuttle. Lawrence Vik was born to John and Sanna Syverson Vik on December 2, 1918, on a farm 3 1/2 miles NW of Tuttle, ND. He was raised and educated in rural Tuttle. Lawrence worked on his parents' farm at various periods throughout the years and also worked for the CCC. Lawrence was a member of the English Lutheran Church of Tuttle. In October of 1979, Lawrence came to make his home at Golden Manor in Steele, ND. He continued to live at the Manor until his death. Reading was a passion for Lawrence. He loved to garden, and read about gardening or hunting. In later years, Lawrence loved to watch the weather, monitoring the temperature several times daily. Lawrence will be remembered for his contagious smile and giggle, quick wit, helping others, and his concern for residents less fortunate than himself. Lawrence is survived by a nephew, Elmer Miller, Jr. JoAnn of Washburn, and three great-nieces Kim, Karmen and Karen. He is also survived by good friend, Gladys Gerr of Steele and all of his "Golden Manor family".
