Lee Jueth, 79, Bismarck, died July 1, 2011, at Medcenter One Hospital in Bismarck after a courageous battle with cancer. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held on Wednesday at 11:00 AM at Church of St. Anne in Bismarck with Rev. Fred Harvey officiating. Burial will be held at ND Veteran's Cemetery. Visitation will be Tuesday from 3:00 - 8:00 PM at Eastgate Funeral Service where a prayer service will be held at 7:00 PM. Visitation will continue on Wednesday one hour prior to the service at the church. Lee was born on September 7, 1931, in Heil, ND, to Frank and Elizabeth Mocho Jueth. He received his education in Heil and Fargo, ND. Lee enlisted in the U.S. Navy and served four years aboard the destroyer, Robert L. Wilson, during the Korean Conflict. After an honorable discharge, he married Susan Gross and to this union, three children were born, Terry, Tammie, and Todd. Lee was very proud of his children and their accomplishments. Lee owned and operated Lee's Auto Body Shop until ill health forced him to retire. He enjoyed gardening, hunting, fishing, and traveling, especially to the yearly naval ship reunions, which took them all over the United States, and a Panama Canal cruise. He was a member of the Bismarck VFW, American Legion, Elks, and Moose. Lee leaves his loving wife of 54 years, Susan; one daughter, Tammie; two sons, Terry and Todd Vicky; two granddaughters, Amanda and Kelsey Jueth; three sisters, Betty Mann, Joyce Jeff Steinley, and Karen Doug Sokolofsky; and four brothers, Donald Jeanie Ulrich, Rod Evon Ulrich, Bob Ulrich, and Tim Ulrich.
