Leona Stroh, 90, Bismarck, died September 3, 2008, at Medcenter One Hospital, Bismarck. Services will be held at 2:00 pm Saturday at House of Prayer Lutheran Church, Bismarck with Rev. David Swonger officiating. Burial will be in Sunset Memorial Gardens, Bismarck. Visitation will be held from 2:00 pm until 9:00 pm Friday at Eastgate Funeral Service, Bismarck with a prayer service beginning at 7:00 pm.
