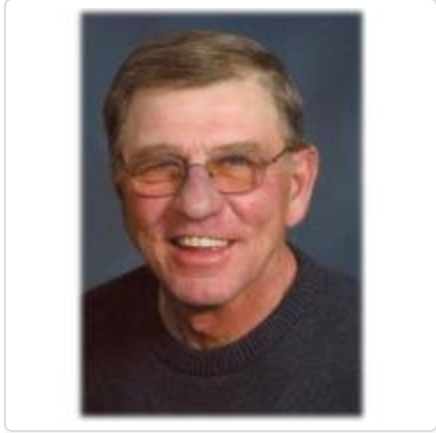




Lloyd Bender

Lloyd Bender, 63, Bismarck, beloved husband and father, lost his battle with cancer on November 23, 2014, at CHI St. Alexius Health, Bismarck.
