Lois J. Zander, 72, Bismarck, formerly of Bremen, ND, passed away on April 30, 2014, at St. Alexius Medical Center, Bismarck. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:30 am Tuesday, May 6, at Church of St. Anne, Bismarck, with Rev. Wayne Sattler officiating. Burial will be at St. John's Catholic Cemetery, New Rockford. Visitation will be held from 5:00 pm – 8:00 pm on Monday, May 5, at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck, where a vigil service will begin at 7:00 pm.
