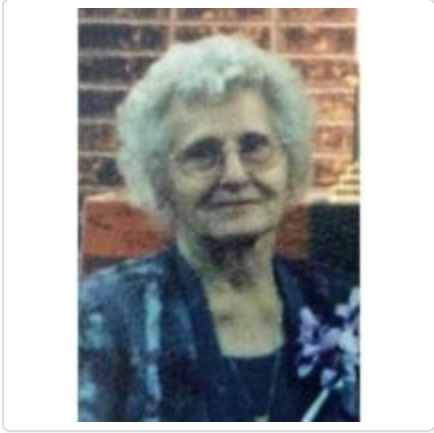




Lorena Irene Dollinger
