Lorna L. Tyson, 98, Bismarck, died October 2, 2014, at Missouri Slope Lutheran Care Center, Bismarck. Lorna married George Tyson in April 1956. He passed away in 1973. He was an assistant engineer for the State Highway Department. Lorna enjoyed hunting, fishing, and bowling.
