Louise C. Friez, 94, Bismarck, died on January 4, 2014, at the Good Samaritan Home in Bismarck, ND. Services will be held at 11:00 am Thursday, January 9, at United Church of Christ, Bismarck, with Rev. Jeannine Kersey-Russel officiating. Visitation will be held from 2:00 pm – 7:00 pm Wednesday, January 8, at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck. Visitation will continue one hour prior to the service at the church. She celebrated her 94th Birthday on September 18, 2013. She was born in Hettinger County near Bentley, North Dakota in 1919, the daughter of Floyd and Pearl Hallam Crary. Louise was one of the last graduates of Bentley High School in the mid-1930's. Most of her adult life was spent in Mott, North Dakota, with her beloved husband, Herbert J. Friez, where they raised their children. Herb died on November 9th, 1997. During her lifetime, in addition to raising her family in loving partnership with Herb, she was a teacher, business woman, and served Hettinger County as Deputy Auditor for over twenty five years. In 1984, Louise and Herb, moved from Mott to Bismarck. Her last two and a half years were spent at the Bismarck Good Samaritan Center, where she provided and received love from a whole new family of dedicated and loving staff, as well as fellow residents. Louise is survived by her three children, Margaret Dahl Bruce, David Friez Connie, Douglas Friez Vicky, eight grandchildren, and twenty-two great grandchildren. She is also survived by a large extended family which includes the Friez in-laws, Rubs, Kleinjans, Crarys and Hallams; as well as a multitude of both lifelong and recent friends.
