Lynn A. Klemetson, 45, died December 8th, 2003 in Davenport, Iowa from Lupus related complications. Funeral Services will be held at 11 AM Friday at McCabe United Methodist Church, Bismarck, with the Rev. Art Scanson officiating. Burial will be in the North Dakota Veterans Cemetery, Mandan with Military Rites provided by the VFW Post #1326. Visitation will be from 9 am until the time of the service at the church. Lynn was born June 10th, 1958 at Hillsboro, ND, the son of Bill & Teddy SletteKlemetson. The family moved to Bismarck in 1968, where Lynn graduated from Century High School in 1976. He then joined the Navy where he served on the USS Ranger Air Craft Carrier. While in the navy he married his high school sweetheart, Brenda Hoffman from Bismarck. They lived in San Diego, CA, until 1980 when they moved back to Bismarck. They owned and operated the Donut Hole Bakery in Bismarck and later Sioux Falls, SD until 1992. At that time they moved to Davenport, Iowa to manage the Bonanza Restaurant. In 2000 Lynn went to work for FED EX until the time of his death. Lynn liked spending time with his family and driving his Corvette. He was a hard worker with a friendly smile who was always ready to reach out and help others. He is survived by his wife and best friend, Brenda, his daughters, Lindsey and Melissa, all of Davenport, Iowa; his parents, Bill & Teddy of Bismarck; his brothers, Paul Evie of Bismarck and Andy of Baldwin, ND; his sister, Peggy Neil Schatz of Cedar Falls, Iowa; and his grandfather, Leonard Slette of Mahanomen, Minnesota.
