Magdalena "Maggie" Wanner, 79, Bismarck, went to meet her Lord on May 2, 2007, at her home surrounded by her family. Services will be held at 10:00 am Saturday at Cathedral of the Holy Spirit, Bismarck, with Rev. Paul Eberle and Rev. Marvin Klemmer officiating. Burial will be in Sunset Memorial Gardens, Bismarck. Visitation will be held from 4:00 pm until 9:00 pm Friday at Eastgate Funeral Service, Bismarck, where a vigil service will be held at 7:00 pm.

Visitation will continue one hour prior to services at the church. Maggie was born on July 4, 1927, at New Leipzig, ND, the daughter of John and Mary Eva Senn Boespflug. As a child, her family moved to New England where her family farmed. She married the love of her life, George Wanner on May 14, 1946 at St. Mary's Church in New England. Maggie and George shared a lifetime of playing cards, going to dances, and the company of their family and friends. You would very seldom see them apart.
