Margaret Gryde Lyng, 78, Bismarck, passed away October 20, 2009, at Missouri Slope Lutheran Care Center, Bismarck. In keeping with Margaret's loving and generous spirit, it was her decision to donate her body to the UND School of Medicine. A memorial service will be held at 2:00 pm Saturday at Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, Bismarck, with Rev. Jeff Tengesdal officiating. Margaret Gryde was born March 9, 1931, at Edinburg, ND, to Edwin and Myrtle Gryde. She attended grade school at Edinburg and high school at Hillcrest Lutheran Academy, Fergus Falls, MN. After high school graduation she graduated from Mayville State University and did advanced studies at the University of Mary, Bismarck, ND. She taught school at Hoople, ND, Fort Knox, KY, and Forman and Linton, ND. Margaret was united in marriage to Orlin I. Lyng on December 24, 1951, at Edinburg, ND. She was a member of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church and active in many church organizations. She had a great faith in God and taught her Christian values to her family. She was involved as a 4H Leader and a Docent at the ND Heritage Center and a volunteer at Missouri Slope Lutheran Care Center.
