Marian Grumbo, 69, died May 1, 2009 in Bismarck. Services will be held at 1:00PM Wednesday, May 6, 2009 at Cathedral of the Holy Spirit, Bismarck, with the Rev. Paul Eberle officiating. Burial will be held at St. Mary's Cemetery. Visitation will be held from 2:00PM until 9:00PM Tuesday, May 5, 2009 at Eastgate Funeral Service, Bismarck, with a vigil at 7:00PM. Marian E.

Slaubaugh was born January 26, 1940 in Rugby, N.D., the daughter of Daniel and Elizabeth Graber Slaubaugh. Marian was raised and educated in Wolford, N.D. and graduated from Wolford High School in 1957. She continued her education at Ann Carlson Business School in Jamestown from 1958 until 1960. Marian's first employment was for Quentin Burdick when he ran for the U.S. Senatorial Campaign in 1960. She then went to work for ND Easter Seal Society until she married Charles Grumbo on November 10, 1962 at St. James Catholic Church in Jamestown, N.D. After their marriage they lived in Bismarck until moving to Fargo in 1968. In 1969 they moved to Belmont, CA until 1970 when they returned to Bismarck. Marian volunteered over the years for different political candidates, stuffing and mailing many envelopes. She enjoyed crafts, card games, and outings with friends at the Elks and the Eagles Club. She is survived by her husband, Charles; her mother, Elizabeth S. Anderson, Wolford, N.D.; three sisters, Catherine David Shrock, Myokka City, FL, Gloria Douville, Detroit Lakes, MN, and Paula Thomas Eigsti, Hutchinson, KS; and one brother, Daniel B. Marlys Slaubaugh, Wolford, N.D. She is also survived by many nephews, nieces, and godchildren. She

was preceded in death by her father, Daniel Slaubaugh; her step-father, Harold Anderson; brother-in-law, Dennis Douville; and a nephew, Dallas Shrock.
