Marie Simon, 81, Bismarck, died December 20, 2009, of respiratory infection at Elm Crest Manor, New Salem, ND. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:30 am Monday, December 28, 2009, at Church of Corpus Christi, Bismarck, with Rev. Paul Becker officiating. Burial will be held in the North Dakota Veteran's Cemetery, Mandan. Visitation will be held from 2 pm until 9:00 pm Sunday at Eastgate Funeral Service, Bismarck, where a rosary service will be held at 7:00 pm. Marie was born July 18, 1928, on the family farm in Linton, ND, the daughter of Joseph and Helen Bosch. She attended country school. Marie lived and worked on the farm until 1957, when she moved to Bismarck and worked at St. Vincent's Care Center from 1957 until 1961. Marie also worked briefly at the Catholic Boys Orphanage in Minneapolis, MN, from August 1955 until December 1955. She met Clement Simon in Bismarck and they were married on October 28, 1961, at Rosendahl Sacred Heart Church, in rural Linton. Marie farmed near Hazelton with Clement as well as raise their five children, until they sold the farm and moved into Strasburg in 1969. Later Marie and Clement moved back to Bismarck where she did housekeeping. Marie loved to collect angels, liked to do word puzzles, listen to old-time German music and enjoyed taking trips to Prairie Knights. Also, she enjoyed visits with her grandchildren. She is survived by her husband, Clement, Bismarck; her daughters, Sandy Simon, Carrollton, GA, Irene Simon, Dickinson, and Jennifer Ray Heupel, Great Falls, MT; her sons, Joseph Tina Simon, Dickinson, and Randy Michele Simon, Hannover;

her brother, Ray Rose Bosch, Linton; and her grandchildren, Samantha, Holly, Bob, Lori, Nick, Alyssa, Kayla, Charity, Emily, CJ, Will, and Stephanie. She was preceded in death by her parents, Joe and Helen Bosch; her sister, Phyllis Klein; and her brothers, Anton and George Bosch.
