Mary Wehmhoefer, 91, Bismarck, died January 27, 2013, at Sanford Health. Funeral services will be held on Thursday at 11:00 AM at Trinity Lutheran Church in Bismarck with Rev. Steve Sathre officiating. Burial will be at the ND Veterans Cemetery. Visitation will be Wednesday from 3:00 - 8:00 PM at Eastgate Funeral Service and will continue on Thursday one hour prior to the service at the church.
