Maurice "Bud" Kulackoski, 87, Bismarck, died July 8, 2011, at the Baptist Home in Bismarck. Funeral services will be held on Thursday, July 14, at 11:00 AM at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck, with Rev. Darrel Aleson officiating. Burial will be at the ND Veteran's Cemetery south of Mandan on Friday at 11:00 AM, with military honors provided by VFW Post #1326. Visitation will be held on Wednesday from 3:00 - 9:00 PM at Parkway Funeral Service and will continue one hour prior to the service at the funeral home. Bud was born on February 29, 1924, in Wilton, ND, to Anton and Marie Bzovwy Kulackoski, the youngest of eight children. He grew up in Wilton and joined the Marines in March 1943. He fought in World War II and in many battles including Tarawa, Gilbert Islands, Okinawa, Ryukyu Islands, and the Occupation of Japan. He was honorably discharged in January 1946. After serving in the military, Bud started his own drywall and painting business which he continued until his retirement.
