Michael A. Krumm, 78, Bismarck, was called home on Sunday, March 17, 2013, at Sanford Health in Bismarck, ND. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 12:30 PM Thursday, March 21, 2013, at Cathedral of the Holy Spirit, 508 Raymond Street, Bismarck, with Rev. Monsignor Thomas Richter officiating. Burial will be in St. Mary's Cemetery. Visitation will be held from 1:00 pm – 9:00 pm Wednesday, March 20, 2013, Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck, where a rosary will begin at 6:45 pm followed by a vigil service at 7:00 pm. Michael was born June 20, 1934, on a farm in Hague, ND, the son of John and Sophia Wingenbach Krumm. He was raised and educated in a country school. He married Mary Bosch at Rosenthal Sacred Church east of Linton, on July 28, 1958. After serving in the Navy, Mike worked in Bismarck where he and Mary raised four wonderful children. Mike's faith and family were his top priorities. When his kids would come to him with worries he would always, with a little frustration in his voice, ask, "What's that going to help?" Reminding them that prayer was anxiety's true remedy, and then he'd call in Novenas. Praying the rosary and novenas were Mike's answer to every problem and worry. He enjoyed every family gathering immensely. He was a man known for his great one-liners, and affectionately known to his grandchildren as G-Pa. His grandchildren loved getting rides from grandpa, as they knew that in the glove compartment they could find grandpa's "treats", which were really blue Halls cough drops. His grandchildren appreciated the numerous hours he spent on the bleachers

cheering them on, Easter egg hunts, playing cards, family breakfasts, and going for ice cream and coffee. Mike had a very generous heart and was never too busy for family and friends.
