Mildred Schell, 94, Bismarck, died February 21, 2005 at Golden Manor, Steele, ND. Services will be held at 11:00 AM Saturday, February 26, at Zion Lutheran Church, Bismarck, with the Rev. Thomas R. Marcis, Jr. officiating. Burial will at 2:00 PM in the McClusky Cemetery Visitation will be from 5:00 to 9:00 PM Thursday, 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM Friday at Boelter-Eastgate Funeral Service, and one hour prior to the service at the church. Mildred was born September 5, 1910 southwest of McClusky, ND, in McClusky Township, the daughter of Elmer R. and Florence Lee Diggins. She was also a volunteer at Medcenter One. She was an active member of St. John's Lutheran Church in McClusky and Zion Lutheran Church in Bismarck. She taught Sunday School, was a member of L.W.M.L., Quilting Circle, and Sight Savers. Mildred is survived by two daughters and one son-in-law, Shirley Jorgensen of McClusky and Marilyn and Merv Gessele of Bismarck; one son and daughter-in-law, Duane and Clara Schell of Minot; eight grandchildren; thirteen great-grandchildren; three step-great-grandchildren; and one great-great-granddaughter.
