Noeletta Neta Seibold, 53, Bismarck, died July 4, 2012, at her home after a courageous fight with cancer. Services will be held at 2 PM Monday, July 9, at the Seventh Day Adventist Church, Bismarck. Burial will be in Fairview Cemetery, Bismarck. Visitation will be held from 4-8 pm Sunday, July 8, at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck. Visitation will continue one hour prior to the service at the church. Neta was born December 8, 1958, in Hettinger, ND, the daughter of James and Berneice Schield Lunday. She was raised and educated in Bismarck through the eighth grade and attended high school at Sheyenne River Academy, where she met her future husband, Mark. They graduated together in 1976, and were married in August 1979 in Bismarck. Neta attended Union College, Lincoln, NE, graduating in 1982 with her Bachelor's degree in elementary education. She was employed as a teacher throughout her life, most recently at Shiloh Christian and Brentwood Christian schools. Though she was a beloved teacher, her life's passion was being a wife and mother. She was the heartbeat of her home and family. She will be greatly missed by anyone who knew her. Neta is survived by her husband, Mark; her children, Arielle Robert Stevens, and Cameron Seibold; her parents, James and Berneice; her sisters, Marga Lonnie Carlson, Amy Darrell Hinger, and Bernelda Randy Lehmann; five nieces and nephews, and many, many friends.
