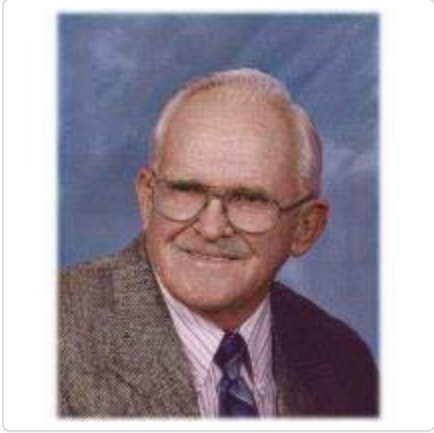




Norman Tosseth

Norman Tosseth, 83, died June 14, 2012, at Missouri Slope Lutheran Care Center in Bismarck. Funeral services will be held on Monday at 2:00 PM at Sunne Lutheran Church in Wilton with Rev.
