Ora Lewis "Louie" Munz, 80, Mandan, died March 2, 2007, at his home. Funeral services will be Wednesday at 1:00 PM at Zion Lutheran Church in Bismarck with Rev. Thomas R. Marcis, Jr. officiating. Burial will be at the North Dakota Veterans Cemetery with military honors provided by VFW Post #1326.
