Patrick M. Crotty, 98, Bismarck, died December 5, 2011, at Medcenter One Hospital, Bismarck. A memorial service will be held at 1:00 pm Friday, December 9, at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck, with Rev. Michael Horn officiating. Burial will be in St. Mary's Cemetery, Bismarck. There will be no visitation, as cremation has taken place. Patrick was born July 16, 1913, on a pioneer wagon train near Helena, MT, the son of Frank and Jenny Copeland Crotty. He spent his formative years in Helena, MT. On August 20, 1947, he married Emeline "Nickie" Nicola. They lived in Pasadena, CA, where they worked in a grocery store. In 1949, they returned to Bismarck, where he operated G & B Grocery Store. In 1958, he began his career with the North Dakota State Penitentiary, and retired in 1978.

Patrick was a member of St. George's Episcopal Church. He had a passion for western history and also enjoyed playing Skipbo. Patrick is survived by three sons, Patrick S. Crotty, Bismarck, Robert J. Linda Thomas, Arvada, CO, and Bradley W. Nancy, Grand Forks; two granddaughters, Annette R. Crotty and Robyn E. Crotty, Denver, CO; sister, Betty Olson, Jackson, MI; and several much loved nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his wife, Emeline; his parents; and seven brothers and sisters.
