



## Paul Whiteman

January 16, 1933 - July 31, 2005

Paul E. Whiteman, 72, Steele, died July 31, 2005 in the Golden Manor, Steele. Services will be held at 10:00 AM Thursday at the Eastgate Steele Memorial Chapel, Steele, with the Rev. Darrel Aleson officiating. Burial will be held at 1:00 PM at the North Dakota Veterans Cemetery, Mandan, with military rites by VFW Post 1326.
