



## Robert "Bob" Hickcox

Robert Hickcox, 78, Bismarck, passed away on March 30, 2008 at Medcenter One St. Vincent's Care Center, Bismarck. Memorial services will be held at 11:00 Thursday at Shepherd of the Valley Lutheran Church, Bismarck. Burial will be in the North Dakota Veteran's Cemetery, Mandan. Visitation will be held from 1:30 pm until 2:30 pm Wednesday at Medcenter One St. Vincent's Care Center, Bismarck. Cremation has taken place. Bob was born on September 8, 1929, in Ree Heights, SD, to Milton and Frances Hickcox. He graduated from Ree Heights High School and later on attended Interstate Business College.
