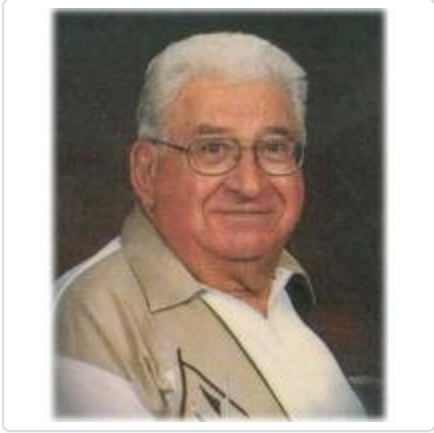




Robert "Booty" Boutrous

December 3, 1926 - October 26, 2008

Robert "Booty" Boutrous, 81, Bismarck, died October 26, 2008, at Medcenter One Hospital. Memorial services will be held at 11:00 am Wednesday, October 29, 2008, at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck, with Rev. Jake Kincaid officiating. Burial will be held at 1:00 pm Wednesday, October 29, 2008 in the North Dakota Veteran's Cemetery, Mandan, with military honors provided by VFW Post #1326. Robert was born December 3, 1926, in Bismarck, ND, the son of Oscar and Barbara Meckler Boutrous. He was raised and attended schools in Bismarck, where he graduated from Bismarck High School in 1944. He went on to attend schools at Bismarck State College and North Dakota State University. Booty served in the US Army and was honorably discharged in 1947. Booty married Jean Mooney on May 16, 1953, in Bismarck. He worked for the North Dakota State Highway Department for over 40 years as a technician in the lab, testing materials for bridge and road construction. Booty was a lifetime member of the American Legion and the Elks Club. He was also involved with the Amvets, Eagles and Moose Clubs. Booty was active in the Bismarck community and served in many ways; including over 50 years with the American Legion "Open Your Heart" at Christmas. Booty played with the Drum and Bugle Corp for many years and also directed the Kids Drum and Bugle Corp through the Bismarck Eagles Club. In his retirement, he and Jean enjoyed their home at Lake Isabel and their travels throughout the country. Booty was an optimistic person who loved life and loved people, and he will be deeply missed. He is

survived by his wife, Jean of Bismarck, ND; his sister, Francis George Wegener of Godfrey, IL; his niece, Barbara Cass of Springfield, IL; his nephew, Jeff Crivello of Ogden, UT; and his grandniece, Carroll Ann Cass of Springfield, IL. He was preceded in death by his parents. Memorials may be given to the North Dakota Veteran's Cemetery, Dakota Zoo, or First Presbyterian Church.
