Robert O. Malling, 67, Bismarck, died June 22, 2007, at his home. Funeral services will be held on Tuesday at 10:30 AM at Faith Lutheran Church in Bismarck with Rev. Wes Aardahl officiating. Burial will be at Sunset Memorial Gardens in Bismarck. Visitation will be Monday from 12:00 - 9:00 PM at Eastgate Funeral Service in Bismarck where a prayer service will be held at 7:00 PM.
