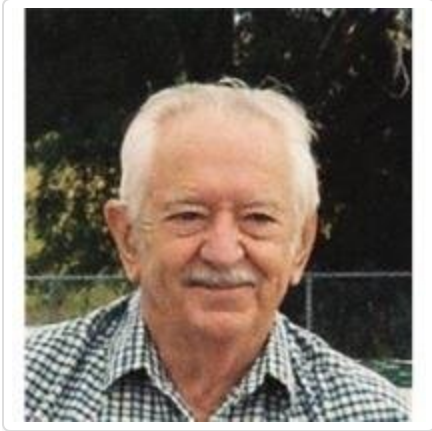




Roy Kuil
