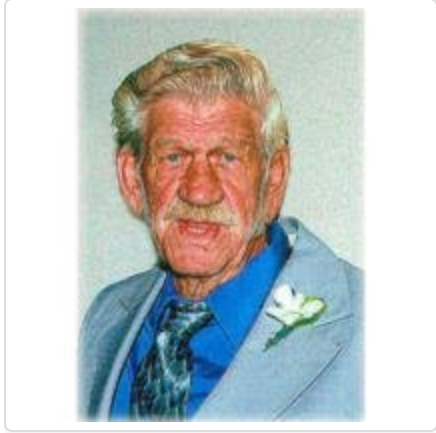




Sandy Dickson

Sandy Dickson, 79, Bismarck, died September 12, 2012, at Sanford Hospital, Bismarck.
