Scott Weigel, 15, Bismarck, died February 12, 2005, at a Bismarck hospital after a short illness. Funeral services will be Tuesday at 10:30 AM at Spirit of Life Catholic Church in Mandan with the Rev. Cyprian Meier officiating. Visitation will be Sunday from 5 - 9 PM and Monday from 9 AM - 4 PM at Eastgate Funeral Service. Visitation will continue Monday from 5 - 7 PM at Spirit of Life Catholic Church in Mandan where a vigil service will be held at 7 PM. Visitation will continue Tuesday one hour prior to the service at the church. Scott was born on December 17, 1989, in Bismarck, the son of Du-Wayne Weigel and Linae Pinks. He lived in Washburn until he was four years old and then moved to Mandan. For the last year and a half, he has lived in Bismarck. He was currently a ninth grader at Simle Middle School.
