Terry Carlyle Jacobson, 55, Bismarck, came to peace with the Lord on December 11, 2014. A memorial service will be held on Sunday at 2:00 PM at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck, with Dennis Sailer officiating. Family will be receiving guests on Saturday from 5:00 – 7:00 PM at the funeral home. Cremation has taken place. Terry was born on August 14, 1959, in Bismarck, ND to Orlin and Shirley Pilgrim Jacobson. He grew up in Bismarck and attended schools at Apple Creek country school, Bismarck High School, and Bismarck Junior College. In 1979, Terry began working for Roy H. Dietz and Sons until he started his own business, Terry's Decorating, doing wall covering, which he did for twenty years. Terry married Laurie "Shorty" Harsche on July 21, 1978, and together they had two children, Heather and Justin. Terry and Shorty enjoyed camping traveling with friends and time on the river. They took great pride in their home that they built in the woods where Terry was able to fulfill his dream of taxidermy. He had a great love for the outdoors and hunting. One of his greatest joys was taking his children, family, friends bear hunting in Canada. He also loved deer hunting and fishing. He was blessed to meet and spend time with his first grandchild, Sawyer Jacobson. Terry is survived by his wife of 36 years, Laurie "Shorty"; his daughter, Heather Michael Baril; his son, Justin Jamie Jacobson; his grandson, Sawyer Jacobson; his father, Orlin
