June 24, 1940 - January 3, 2010

Theodore DeWall, Jr., 69, Bismarck, died January 3, 2010, at a Bismarck care center. Funeral services will be held on Friday at 1:30 PM at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck, with Rev. Clyde Zimbelman officiating. Burial will be at Sunset Memorial Gardens. Visitation will be held on Thursday from 9:00 AM – 7:00 PM at Parkway Funeral Service where a prayer service will be held at 7:00 PM. Visitation will continue on Friday one hour prior to the service at the funeral home. Theodore was born on June 24, 1940, at Steele, ND, the son of Theodore Sr. and Olive Mary Marquett DeWall. He was raised on the family farm near Steele until his junior year of high school when he moved to Bismarck. While he was in high school, he joined the National Guard in 1958. He then graduated from Bismarck High School in 1959. Theodore married Dorothy D. Dockter on July 16, 1961. He entered the US Army and served in France and at Fort Ord, CA, and was discharged in 1964. Theodore did odd jobs here and there until 1965 when he began working for John Deere Company in Bismarck. He worked there until 1983 when it closed. He then worked here and there until June 1993 when he began working for the ND State Water Commission until his retirement in August 2007. He is survived by his wife, Dorothy of Bismarck; his daughter, Kimberly Ann Brian Lee Munsch; his son, Kelly D. Dewall; five grandchildren, Jeramie and Stephanie Munsch, Amanda Rae Davis, Dallas Dean Carsen, and Aurora Sky DeWall; one great-grandchild, C'aira Rae Davis; his father, Theodore DeWall, Sr., all of Bismarck; one sister, Ellen Faye Doyle Laib of

Lincoln; and one brother, Richard DeWall of Bismarck. He was preceded in death by his mother, Olive Mary DeWall and his grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. George DeWall and Mr. and Mrs. Alfred Potts.
