Thomas E. Kuhn, 59, Dawson, died September 6, 2004 in a Bismarck hospital. Services will be held at 10:30 AM Friday, at St. Francis de Sales Catholic Church, Steele, with the Rev. Jerome Hunkler officiating. Burial will be in the Dawson Cemetery. Visitation will be from 1:00 PM to 9:00 PM Thursday at Eastgate Steele Memorial Chapel, where a family prayer/scripture service will be held at 7 PM. Tom was born September 26, 1944, to Wendelin and Ella Meidinger Kuhn at Napoleon, ND, where he was raised and educated. He worked for Boeing Aircraft in Seattle, Washington, for three years and in 1969, was drafted into the U.S. Army. He spent thirteen months in Vietnam. After an honorable discharge from the Army, Tom worked for several construction firms. On October 18, 1975, Tom married Connie Himmerich. They lived in Dawson for the past 24 years. He worked as a heavy equipment operator for Northern Improvement for 20 years. Tom enjoyed hunting and the outdoors. He always knew where to find the geese.
