Vernice Ella Thieling, 89, Tuttle, died November 7, 2010, at the Good Samaritan Society Care Center, Bismarck, after a short illness. Services will be held at 11:00 am Wednesday, November 10, 2010, at the United Methodist Church, Tuttle, with Rev. Thomas Bowsler officiating. Burial will be in the Tuttle Cemetery. Visitation will be from 4:00 pm until 8:00 pm Tuesday, November 9, at Eastgate Funeral Service, Bismarck. Visitation will continue one hour prior to the service at the church. Vernice the fifth child of ten was born February 10, 1921, in Kidder County, ND, the daughter of Will and Nellie Dodge Thieling. She was raised and educated in Tuttle, and graduated from Tuttle High School. After receiving her teacher's certificate, she taught several years in Burleigh and Kidder county schools.
