November 21, 1929 - March 23, 2006

Wayne "Bud" Gluesing, 76, Bismarck, died March 23, 2006, in his home. A memorial service will be held April 7, 2006 at 1 PM at Trinity Lutheran Church, with the Rev. Nate Keith officiating. Wayne was born November 21, 1929 in Denison, IA, the son of Arthur and Lulu Vogt Gluesing. He was raised in Denison and later moved to Wichita, KS, where he was a motorcycle patrolman.
