Wayne F. Hill, 93, of Red Lodge, MT, formerly of Mandan and Ellendale, ND, died early Friday morning, September 8, 2006, at Cedar Wood Villa in Red Lodge. Funeral Services will be held at 11:00 AM on Thursday at Parkway Funeral Service Chapel with Rev. Ben Dove officiating. Visitation will be from 9-11AM Thursday at Parkway Funeral Service. Burial will be held at 11:00 AM on Friday, at the Ellendale City Cemetery. Wayne was born on April 26, 1913, in Monango, ND, a son of Ross and Lillian Kingsbury Hill. He was raised on a farm near Ellendale and graduated from Ellendale High School. He later earned a Master's Degree in Business Administration from the University Of North Dakota. While in high school and college, Wayne excelled in track and field events in the upper Midwest. Wayne married Anna May Crabtree on September 1, 1937, in Ellendale. They lived in Mandan where Wayne taught at the public high school. They moved to Ellendale in 1946 where he was a professor at Ellendale State Teacher's College until 1968. Thereafter, he became president of First National Bank, retiring in 1971 and returning to live in Mandan. Anna May died on December 3, 1977. Wayne married V. Irene Chase on December 10, 1978, and she preceded him in death on December 4, 1999. He was also preceded in death by two brothers, Howard and Gerald. Mr. Hill moved to Red Lodge, MT, in August of 2005 to be near his son and daughter-in-law. He enjoyed all outdoor activities, and was particularly fond of gardening and bird watching. Survivors include his son, Dr. W. Allen Hill and his wife, Jeanette, of Red Lodge; three step-daughters, Patsy Larson, Wanda

Pettler, and Enid Westberg; two grandchildren, Stephen Hill and Elizabeth Potter; two step-grandchildren, Heidi Pautsch and Brandon Hoffman; and seven great-grandchildren.
