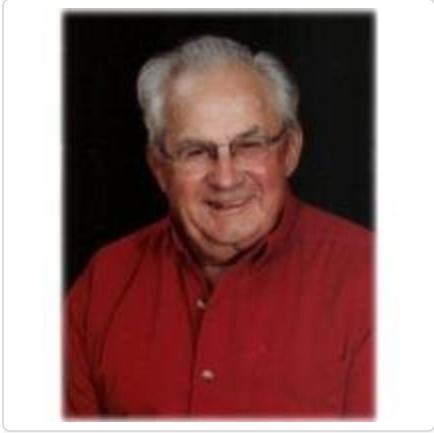




Wilfred "Willie" Braun
